The Town of Mamakating Camp will be held at Mamakating Town Park in Bloomingburg. Camp is an 8 weeks program that will start on June 27<sup>th</sup> and run through August 19, 2016. Camp starts at 9am and ends at 3pm and a before and after camp is also available at an additional cost. Camp is open to all campers ages 5-14 years of age. Campers ages 5 & 6 will be in a specialized age appropriate Pee-Wee Camp each day. Our campers are equipped with a fully operational swimming pool which will be incorporated into our camper's daily activities. In addition both camp buildings are air conditioned and available for all children throughout the day.

**CAMP DISCIPLINE POLICY:**

Discipline is most effective when it deals directly with the problem at the time and place it occurs, and in a way that campers view as fair and impartial. Counselors and administrative staff are expected to use disciplinary action (in the form of time-out from activities) only when necessary. Disciplinary action should be firm, fair, and consistent so as to be the most effective in changing camper behavior. We will always consider the following: the camper’s age, nature of the incident, and the circumstances that led to it, camper’s prior disciplinary record, and the effectiveness of prior discipline (time-outs). As a general rule discipline will be progressive, meaning camper’s first infraction will merit a lighter penalty, (a shorter time-out) than subsequent infractions. Camp counselors are instructed to inform a Director if a camper exhibits violent behavior, bullying or a regular pattern of misbehavior. In such cases, Director will speak with the camper, if the misbehavior continues; the Director will notify parent/guardian to discuss possible options. In the case of extremely violent behavior, we reserve the right to dismiss a camper from the summer program without warning.

TOWN OF MAMAKATING SUMMER CAMP COLOR RUN FOR FUN PERMISSION SLIP

Weather permitting; this event will take place sometime in August

The course will take place throughout the park and winds around the campus passing through the color zones on the banners. This is not a race, so go at your own pace and enjoy the course. Participants are sprayed with different colors at each color station.

THE ZONES will have counselors who will throw non-toxic colored powder for each course a camper completes. The counselors will do their best to throw the powder at the torso, but wind and other factors can cause the powder to get on the face. Wearing goggles or sunglasses will help to avoid flying colored powder in the eyes. The color zone can be bypassed completely if a camper does not wish to go through it.

THE POWDER is a non-toxic color cornstarch powder that will likely wash out of clothing. However, we recommend that you wear light colored clothing that you don't mind being "colored" We also recommend you bring a change of clothes and a towel or sheet to cover your seat for your car ride home.

Please carefully read and sign the permission form below if you choose to allow your child to participate in this event.

I hereby consent for my child/children listed below to participate in the Color Run for Fun event. I am aware that this recreation program requires physical and mental fitness. My child is in adequate physical and mental condition to participate in the program.
