Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statement - 2014

The term "Interest" means a direct or indirect financial or material benefit, but does not include any benefit arising from the provision or receipt of any services generally available to the residents or taxpayers of the municipality or an area of the municipality, or a lawful class of such residents or taxpayers. A municipal officer or employee is deemed to have an interest in any private organization when he or she, his or her spouse, or a member of his or her household is an owner, partner, member, director, officer, employee or directly or indirectly owns or controls more than 5% of the organization's outstanding stock.

2. The term "Relative" means a mother, father, grandmother, grandfather, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, son, daughter, step-parent, step-brother, step-sister, or step-child, including any such relationship by adoption, marriage, civil union, or same sex marriage.

8. Did or do you or a relative hold a position with the Town or Villages or with any organization regulated by the Town or Villages, or which regularly did or does business with the Town or Villages? If yes, please describe.

9. List all Real Estate holdings within the boundaries of the Town of Mamakating, and/or Village of Bloomingburg and/or Village of Wurtsboro which you or a relative own or have a partial interest, including any mortgages you or a relative hold on a Town or Villages property.

This disclosure form must be filed with the Town Clerk within ten (10) days after taking office or becoming employed with the Town. This form must be amended ten (10) days after any relevant change in financial circumstances. Current Town officials and employees must file a new disclosure form with the Town Clerk within ten (10) days of January 1st of each year they hold office. Completed disclosure forms should be submitted in a sealed envelope labeled on the outside with the name of the officer or employee.

A reporting individual who knowingly and willfully fails to file an annual statement of disclosure or who knowingly and willfully with intent to deceive makes a false statement or gives information which such individual knows to be false on such statement of disclosure filed pursuant to this section shall be assessed a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed Ten Thousand and No/100 (\$10,000) Dollars.

A municipality may, in lieu of a civil penalty, refer a violation to the appropriate prosecutor and upon such conviction, but only after such referral, such violation shall be punishable as a Class A misdemeanor.
